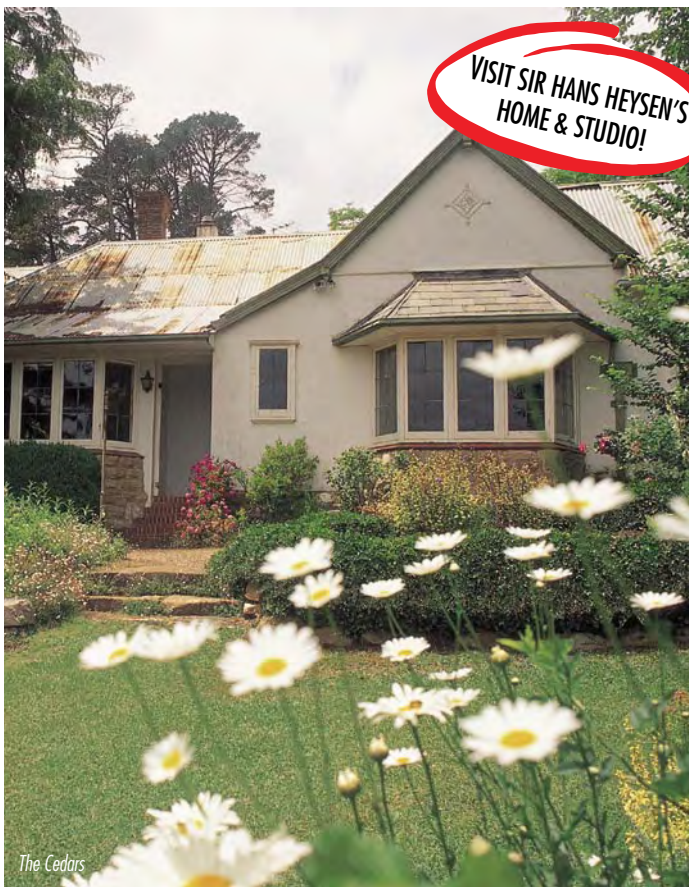


# Grand Barossa with The Cedars
