Kakadu is a land rich in wonderful diversity - Savannah woodlands, great rivers, flood plains, billabongs teeming with life, stoneland escarpments and Aboriginal Dreamtime. These are just some facets of a primitive land unchanged since the beginning of time. Come - experience Kakadu and be amazed.

HIGHLIGHTS:

DAY ONE: Darwin - Kakadu

- Top end outback bush - eucalypts, palms and termite mounds
- Kakadu National Park on the South Alligator River - a vast pristine wetland and bushland habitat with significant Aboriginal culture
- Take a short guided walk to Nourlangie Rock and see ancient Aboriginal rock art
- Enjoy a tropical buffet lunch with cold meats, salad and fruit
- Take a 1.5 hour guided cruise on Yellow Water Billabong
- Look for crocodiles, brolgas, magpie geese and kytes
- Take in the serenity and beauty that nature offers in the Kakadu wetlands
- Visit Warradjan Aboriginal Cultural Centre and learn of the traditional ways of Aboriginal people in Kakadu.

DAY TWO: Kakadu - Darwin

- Follow the Oenpelli Road to the northern area of Kakadu
- Take a guided walk at Ubirr Rock - a noted Aboriginal art site
- Witness views over rocky outcrops and the Nardah flood plain
- Board the Guluyambi cruise with an Aboriginal guide on the East Alligator River
- Rocky escarpments, tall trees and sandy beaches
- Look for crocodiles - on the banks and swimming!
- Walk at a rocky outcrop on the Arnhem Land shore of the East Alligator River
- Learn about hunting and gathering techniques used by Aboriginals
- Enjoy a boxed picnic salad lunch
- Visit the Bowali Visitor Centre - an interpretive display of Kakadu's development and management
- Explore fascinating termite mounds on the return to Darwin.

Weather conditions and cultural requirements of the Aboriginal people may necessitate a different itinerary. Please bring drinking water. Swimming is not permitted on this tour.
