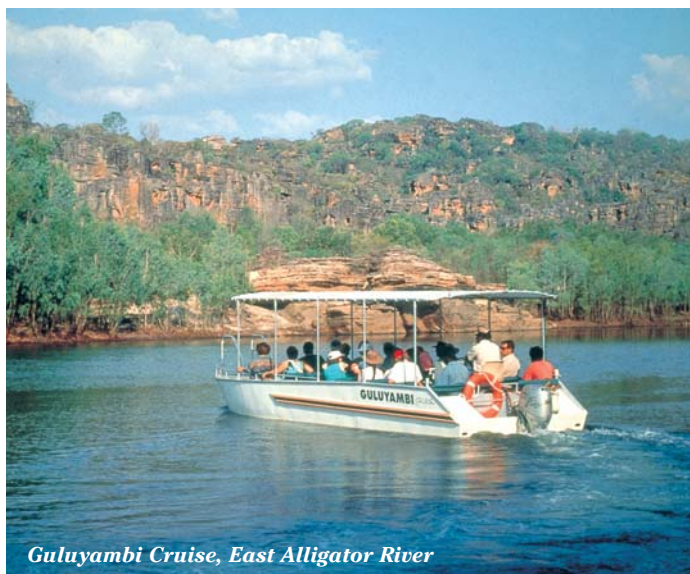

A World Heritage National Park, Kakadu is spectacular. The flood plains, billabongs and lagoons drained by the Alligator Rivers and the soaring rocky Arnhem Land escarpments cut by fantastic gorges, waterfalls and streams provide amazing scenery.

Yet it is the wildlife, the wonderful profusion of birds, the fearsome crocodiles lurking on the mudslides, billabongs resplendent in the colour of water lilies, the Aboriginal art work painted on rock cave walls which tell the story of Dreamtime that will captivate you.

### HIGHLIGHTS:

#### **DAY ONE: Darwin - Kakadu**

- Follows the itinerary of Day One - Kakadu Two Days Tour 824

#### **DAY TWO: Arnhem Land 4WD**

- Head out to Arnhem Land taking a break at Border Store
- Ford (cross) the East Alligator River that divides Kakadu and Arnhem Land
- Skirt towering escarpments, billabongs and flood plains in the Mikinj Valley
- Experience the environment of a tranquil billabong - jabirus, sea eagles, whistling kytes, crocodiles and plant life
- Explore a rocky outcrop where your guide will explain about Aboriginal rock art
- By arrangement with Manilakarr, Mandjurinunj and Bunitj people visit Oenpelli Aboriginal Community - perhaps meet some local people

- Watch as local Aboriginals create artwork at Injalak
- Opportunity to browse and purchase Aboriginal art
- Visit Jacobs Hand - a ceremonial rock art site
- Cross the flood plains to Inkiyu - a stunning billabong with a vast sandy beach set below a sheer escarpment
- Take a leisurely walk in this pristine environment
- Enjoy a boxed picnic salad lunch with Billy Tea amongst these perfect surrounds
- Visit an Aboriginal ceremonial site and a burial site with rock art on the sandstone cliff faces.

#### **DAY THREE: Kakadu - Darwin**

- Follows the itinerary of Day Two - Kakadu Two Days Tour 824.
