HIGHLIGHTS:

- Riverside suburbs and yacht clubs south of Perth
- Market gardens and orchards around Donnybrook - home of the Granny Smith apple
- The Diamond Tree - a one time bushfire watch tower atop a 51 metre Karri tree
- Experience the Tree Top walk at the Valley of the Giants - exciting, dramatic!
- Walk along the elevated walkway rising to 44 metres through the forest canopy
- Take the Ancient Empire Walk down into the twisted gnome like darkness of the Tingle Tree forest
- Traverse pathways in the gloom of the forest floor and explore hollowed buttressed bases of the centuries old Giants
- Visit the stunning coastline of William Bay - renowned for its windswept granite tors
- Travel inland via Mt Barker and Kojonup
- Return to Perth stopping for dinner at the Kodja Place Visitors Centre (own expense).
