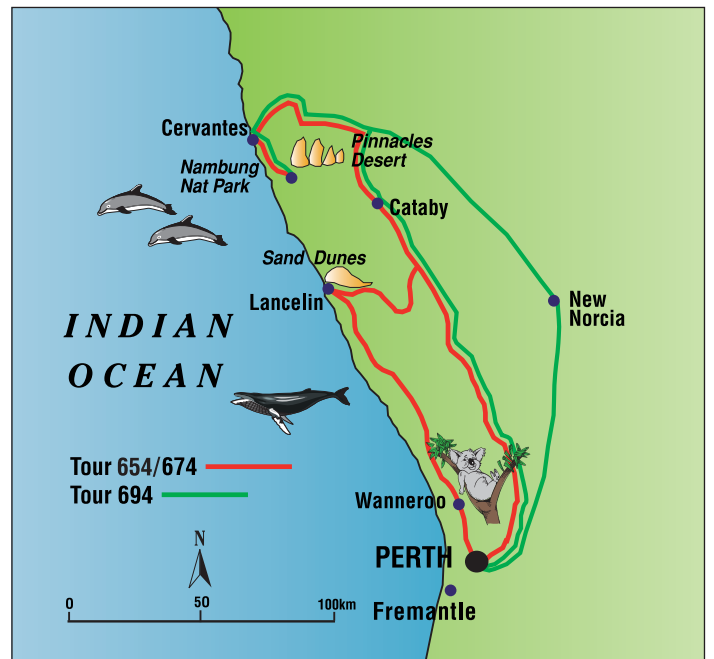

The thrilling adventure of 4 wheel driving off-road at the Lancelin Sand Dunes, is an unparalleled way of discovering this awesome environment.



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HIGHLIGHTS:

- Take a guided walk through the Pinnacles desert limestone pillars created by the forces of nature
