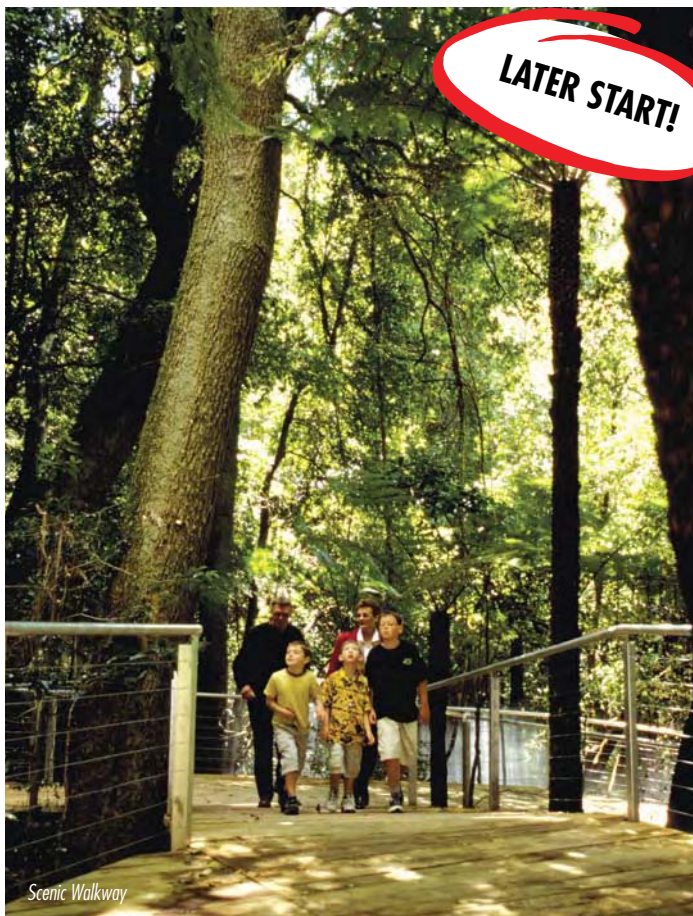


Blue Mountains Express

- At Echo Point, see the Three Sisters rock formation towering over Jamison Valley
- Opportunity to ride the world's steepest Scenic Railway, Scenic Cableway or Scenic Skyway (own expense)
- Walk on the valley floor boardwalk under a canopy of tall tree ferns
- Follow the scenic Cliff Drive with magnificent views over Megalong Valley from Narrowneck
- Visit the quaint mountain village of Leura
- Perhaps enjoy a local specialty as guests of Maurice Cooper (Mr. Teapot) at Bygone Beautys... a traditional English Tea or a Devonshire Tea of scones, jam and cream. What a treat! (own expense)
- Time to walk and browse the picturesque mountain village of Leura
- Pass Homebush Bay - the 2000 Olympic Games site. See the stadiums and facilities of the millenium Olympics.
- Return to Sydney over the Anzac Bridge.
